Each year Pioneer Arts schedules 10 general meetings each on the second Wednesday of the month. The HIGHLIGHT of the general meeting is the presentation by a guest artist in the form of a demonstration or lecture. These informative sessions are open to the public and are free unless we secure a nationally recognized artist. Then, a small fee will be charged to the public.

November through April meetings are held from 1pm to 3pm. May through October the meetings are from 7pm to 9pm. The time change is to allow the working members the opportunity to attend at least 5 of the meetings and demonstrations. The meetings are located at the Center For The Arts, 314 W. Main Street, Grass Valley, CA.



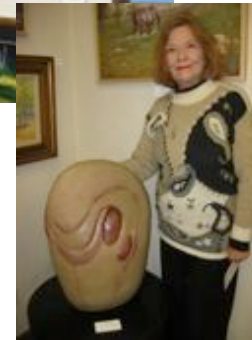
To complete the year, two informal gatherings are held on selected weekends in July and December.

There are two exhibitions annually; a Spring Membership Show and in the Fall the Northern Mines Show which is juried and open to all visual artists located in Northern and Central California.
